IMPORTANT NOMINATION MEETING INFORMATION

In accordance with Section 73 of the NESKONLITH CUSTOM ELECTION REGULATIONS, qualified electors must be physically present at the Nomination meeting to nominate candidates. Additionally, there are a number of provisions within PART 9 of the NESKONLITH CUSTOM ELECTION REGULATIONS, including payment of a \$200 fee, that MUST be satisfied in order for a nomination and candidate qualifications to be approved by the Chief Electoral Officer.

Please also note that, in accordance with Section 5-6 of the NESKONLITH CUSTOM ELECTION REGULATIONS, one council position shall be open only to a Salmon Arm candidate who, upon nomination, signs a declaration and provides proof to the Electoral Officer within 48 hours that they are ordinarily resident on Switsemalph 3 Reserve.
