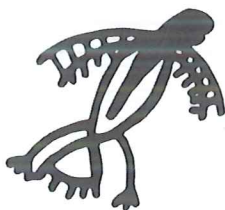

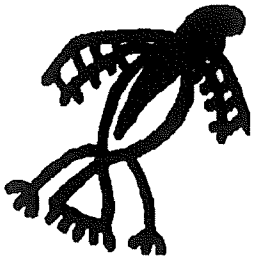

# Construction Craft Worker – Level 1

## Course Outline

**Taught and Certified by Thompson River University Instructors.**  
**July 16 to September 28, 2018 @ the Neskonlith Education Centre**

A Construction Craft Worker (Labourer) works mostly on construction sites in residential, institutional, commercial and industrial settings, including pipelines, utilities, hydroelectric dams, roadways, bridges tunnels, shipyards, mining and railways. Construction Craft Worker tasks include site preparation and cleanup, setting up and removing access equipment, and assisting on concrete, masonry, steel, wood and pre-cast erection projects. They handle materials and equipment and perform demolition, excavation and compaction activities. They may also perform site safety and security checks.

The Construction Craft Worker program introduces you to the skills, training and knowledge needed to gain employment as construction craft workers in any heavy construction and resource industry.

Supplemented with entry level course on pipeline utility construction  
Participants will receive following safety tickets.

- Fall Arrest Certification,
- Aerial Platform,
- H2S Alive Certification,
- Ground Disturbance Level 1,
- Confined Spaces,
