Re: Geotechnical Investigation on IR3 starting March 29th, 2021.

Dear Neskonlith Band membership and community members,

Neskonlith has been working to identify and develop economic opportunities on Neskonlith reserves.

IR3 has been identified as having land development potential.

A geotechnical investigation needs to be completed before further planning can occur. The purpose of a geotechnical investigation is to excavate some test pits into the ground so that we can identify areas of potential instability so that we can avoid these areas of instability when we are creating a final development plan.

We plan to use a small excavator to install up to 20 test pits up to 4m in depth. We will then backfill these test pits upon completion. The investigation should take up to three days to complete and **will likely start the week of March 29th, 2021.**

Although we don't have a test pitting plan yet, we have plotted known archaeological values on the map so that we can avoid them. We will also have a cultural monitor present that will have the authority to stop the test pitting if cultural heritage resources are encountered. The test pits will also be located to minimize disturbance to vegetation.
